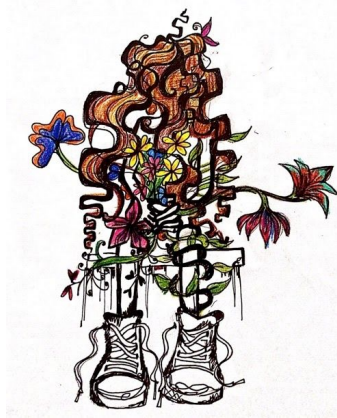


# Science as Art
